Further agreements signed to increase distribution points

Bank Rakyat is a licensed financial institution in Malaysia with over 100 branches nationwide and circa 120 Automated Teller Machines ('ATMs'). The agreement with Key Elite enables MobilityOne Malaysia to sell its products and services via the distribution points located at CNI's distribution centres, through its e-commerce website and via short messaging services ('SMS') for CNI's distributors. CNI currently has 66 distribution centers and approximately 250,000 distributors throughout Malaysia.

Rahaman, Chief Executive Officer of MobilityOne, commented: 'These agreements will allow us to further expand our distribution channels and provide access to both institutions' extensive customer bases. The addition of both Bank Rakyat and Key Elite builds upon the already impressive list of business partners that use our proprietary technology platform.'
